Frank's Myth Sci-Fi Band The Barracudas are joined by Valerie C. Wisecracker and Grant Livingston to morph into what can only be described as a genre unto itself: country sci-fi as invented by William Frank Smith, who wrote all the songs. This "Spaced Out" storytelling band performs songs with tongue in cheek sci-fi, stand-alone lyrics, like back when there were rocket ships, ray guns, and robots. Titles like Bugman, Brussel Sprouts from Mars, When Roaches Get Brains, The Milky Way Bar, Electrical Man, and The Collector take you on an intergalactic tour of Frank Smith's amazing mind.

Mike Barra and the Barracudas It's all-original countrybluesjazzrockfolk time with Mike Barra, a local singer songwriter who's been performing in south Florida since the early seventies. Mike's been writing songs for 48 years and playing guitar for 52. He's lyrical and often satirical, typically captivating his audience and drawing their hearts into the world of his tunes. A roller-coaster ride of emotion guaranteed. Barra is honored to be joined by some amazing musicians that he calls a hot-rod rhythm section: John Holland, Sean Dibble, Alex Moreno, and sometimes Sean Edelson.

The September Song Swap will be at 8445 SW 181 Terrace September 9, hosted by Jim and Kathy Teas, from 5:00 to 9:00 PM

From the US 1 – Turn onto SW 168th Street. Proceed past traffic circle. Turn right on SW 84th Avenue (note: speed bumps). Turn right on SW 181 Terrace. House is third on right with brick mailbox.

From the Old Cutler Road – Turn onto SW 168th Street. Proceed just past second bridge and turn left on SW 84th Avenue (note: speed bumps). Turn right on SW 181 Terrace. House is third on right with brick mailbox.

From Turnpike: Exit at SW 184th Street and turn left. Proceed across US 1 to SW 87th Avenue and turn left. Turn right on SW 181 Street (note: speed bumps). Turn right on SW 84th Avenue and right on SW 181 Terrace. House is third on right with brick mailbox.

Folk Club Format for the song circle:

All performers (poets, dancers, singers, musicians) will enter their names on the signup sheet as they arrive. Those who are not going to perform, but who wish to hear a song, may write the name of the song on a separate signup sheet. The performers, at their sole discretion, may select the requested song(s) to play during their turns; the performers will take turns in the order on the signup sheet.

Song Swap Etiquette:

* If you are playing a song, you may tell the group whether you wish for others to join in or not. If you are singing or playing while another person is taking his/her turn, sing or play softer than the lead performer.

* Keep your selection to 5 minutes or less. Be prepared when it's your turn so we can keep the circle moving.

•Song Swap Pot Luck Supper: bring supper enough food for six; extra if you are bringing a guest.
